From Intellogist to WIPO INSPIRE


- “Intellogist” platform discontinued with rights acquired by WIPO – in 2017
- Prototype platform as basis for full development – end 2018
- User experience, definition of data and visual structure – mid 2019
- Rebranded as WIPO INSPIRE (**I**ndex of **S**pecialized **P**atent **I**nformation **R**eports) – mid 2019
- WIPO INSPIRE planned launch by end 2019

Initial Principal Features of WIPO INSPIRE

- Reports platform: Provides details of patent and non-patent information databases and systems in a structured format
- Coverage map: Visualizes the coverage of different databases and search systems on a world map
- Resource comparison: Allows users to compare two different patent databases or patent search systems

Reports platform

- Specify the name of the database or filter reports based on predefined criteria

MALAYSIA - MY

Jurisdiction - General Information

Malaysia is a member of the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since August 16, 2006, and a member of the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since January 1, 1989.

Malaysia is also part of the regional IP information platform ASEAN Patentscope which is accessible at this [link](#).

More legal information about intellectual property-related laws and regulations of Malaysia can be found on WIPO Lex at this [link](#).

Online Patent Register and Online Gazette

Malaysia has an **Online Register** which is accessible at this [link](#) and an **Online Gazette** accessible at this [link](#).

Features and search functionalities

The online patent register has an **English interface**.

Through the patent register one can retrieve information on **Legal Status Events** and **PCT National Entry Phase**.

The patent register can also be searched by **Applicant/Inventor Name**.

Registered users only have access to advanced search functionalities.

On ASEAN Patentscope, it is also possible to search for Malaysian patents on an English interface by **PCT Application/Publication Number** and by **Applicant/Inventor Name**, and to retrieve information on **Legal Status Events**, **Priority Data**, and **PCT National Entry Phase**.

The Online Gazette is published in English every four weeks. Only the editions of the last 12 to 14 months are available online. It contains a list of patents basic data.

Additional Information

Particularities of patent protection in Malaysia

The patents are granted for 20 years from filing under the current law; however applications filed before 1.8.2001 and not granted at that date could avail of the previous law that provided a protection for 15 years from the grant.

Legal Status Search tips

Fee Payment is not reported but the end of protection date indicated is an indirect indication that annual fees have been paid, and this date will change when the next annual fees are paid.

An example of a **Legal Status Event** is "to published as lapsed patent" for "Application No" PI 20000918.

On ASEAN Patentscope, it is also possible to search for Malaysian patents on an English interface by **PCT Application Number**, e.g., by selecting the box "PCT Filing #" for PCT/US2015/034271.
